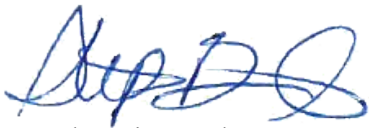
The motion passed 4:0.

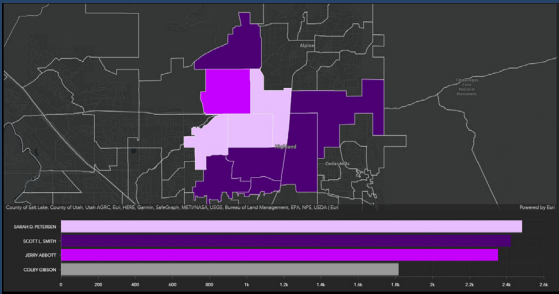
